**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education is considering undertaking certain improvements to the athletic facilities at Horace Greely High School (the "Project"), comprising:

- 1. the installation of artificial turf on the stadium field;
- 2. replacement of the running track;
- 3. installation of lighting for the stadium field;
- 4. resurfacing the tennis courts;
- 5. replacement of the existing tennis court lighting;
- 6. construction of a new entrance plaza and walkway for the stadium field:
- 7. cosmetic improvements to the concession stand;
- 8. installation of a new scoreboard; and
- 9. partial replacement of the gymnasium roof.

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act statute (Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law) and implementing regulations ("SEQRA"), the Board of Education has determined that the Project is a Type II action as defined in Section 617.5 of Title 6 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") and not subject to SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, that, to assist it in its decision-making, the Board of Education authorized the WBA Group, Inc. to prepare an Environmental Assessment Form ("EAF") to evaluate the Project's potential for environmental impacts, which document is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the EAF concludes that due to, *inter alia*, the infrequency of evening games that would occur as a result of the Project, any increase in evening traffic generation or noise would not rise to the level of significance; that the new lighting will be so designed to minimize spillover and glare and therefore will not have significant adverse impacts on the neighboring community; and that the other elements of the project will not result in changes to the overall operations of the High School athletic facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board finds, after review of the EAF, that the Project is exempt from SEQRA and that it would not have any significant adverse environmental impacts; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board will proceed to determine whether it will undertake the Project.

# YORKTOWN CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT CONTRACT FOR HEALTH AND WELFARE SERVICES

This agreement made in duplicate this <u>27th</u> day of <u>FEBRUARY</u> by and between the Board of Education, <u>CHAPPAQUA SCHOOL DISTRICT</u>, County of Westchester, New York, (the School District of Residence) and the Board of Education of the towns of Yorktown, New Castle and Cortlandt, County of Westchester, New York (Yorktown Central School District).

WITNESSETH, that whereas the School District of Residence is duly empowered by the provisions of Section 912 of the Education Law to enter into a contract for the purposes of providing health and welfare services to the children residing in said school district and attending non-public schools in the Yorktown Central School District, to begin on <u>September 6, 2011</u> and to end on <u>June 22, 2012</u>.

NOW, therefore, the School District of Residence agrees to pay the Yorktown Central School District the sum of \$1,112.61 per pupil for health and welfare services provided to 1 child(ren) residing in the District of Residence and attending non-public schools in the Yorktown Central School District. It is further agreed that at the end of the current Yorktown school year the foregoing charge will be recomputed using actual expenditures for health and welfare services and actual enrollment as of October 1, and that a refund or additional charge will be made as required on the basis of said recomputation.

And the Yorktown Central School District hereby agrees with the School District of Residence as follows:

- 1. That the following services to be provided shall include, but not limited to, services performed by a physician, dentist, dental hygienist, nurse, school psychologist, school social worker, and school speech correctionist; taking of medical histories; vision and hearing tests; examination for employment certificates; notification of parents regarding defects and follow-up; instructions for first aid care for school emergencies.
- 2. The Yorktown Central School District will also furnish the following to be used in providing such services as requested by the non-public school authorities: Supplies and equipment for use by physician, school nurse, psychologist, dental hygienist, social worker, and speech correctionist (i.e., Scales, Vision and hearing testing devices, Health record forms, First-aid supplies and all other readily transportable equipment and supplies pertaining to delivery of services).

It is expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that the services agreed to be supplied under this contract shall not include any teaching services.

## **CONTRACT FOR HEALTH & RELATED SERVICES**

HARRISON CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TOWNS OF HARRISON, RYE & NORTH CASTLE HARRISON, NEW YORK 10528

THIS AGREEMENT made in duplicate on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2012 by and between the Board of Education of Chappaqua Central School District, County of Westchester (Putnam/Rockland), New York, party of the first part, and the Board of Education of Harrison Central School District, Towns of Harrison, Rye and North Castle, Westchester County, New York, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that whereas party of the first part has been duly empowered by a vote of the majority of the qualified voters present at a school meeting of said school district under the provisions of Section 912 of the Education Law to enter into a contract for the purpose of providing health and related services for children residing in said school district and attending non-public schools in Harrison Central School District, Towns of Harrison, Rye and North Castle, Westchester County, New York to begin on September 1, 2011 and to end on June 30, 2012.

NOW, therefore, the said party of the first part hereby agrees to pay to the party of the second part the sum of \$1,056.36 per child, for health and related services to be provided to approximately 4 child/children residing in said school district and attending non-public schools in said Harrison Central School District, Towns of Harrison, Rye and North Castle, County of Westchester, New York.

And the party of the second part hereby agrees with the party of the first part as follows:

- 1. That the services to be provided shall consist of the following: Annual medical inspection, school nursing service, vision and hearing tests, exams for employment certificates, examinations for participation in athletics, notification of parents regarding defects and follow-up, instructions for first aid care for school emergencies and psychological services.
- 2. The party of the second part will also furnish the following equipment to be used in providing such services if requested by the authorities in charge of the non-public school: vision and hearing testing devices, health record forms.

It is expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that the service agreed to be supplied under this contract shall not include any teaching service.

It is mutually agreed that this contract shall not become valid and binding upon either party thereto until the same shall be approved by the Superintendent of Schools.

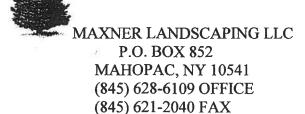
