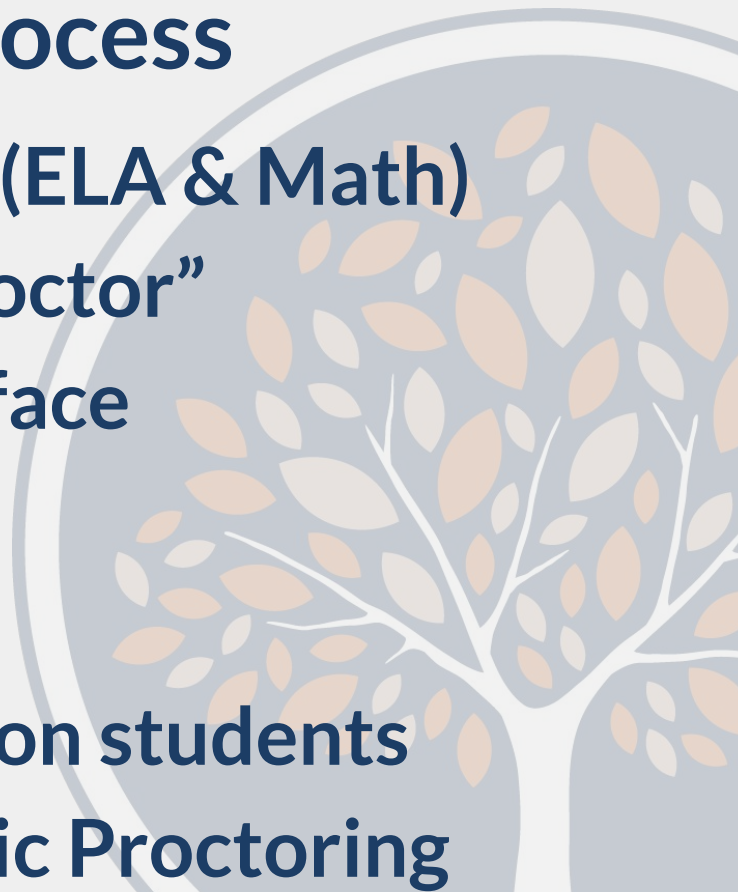

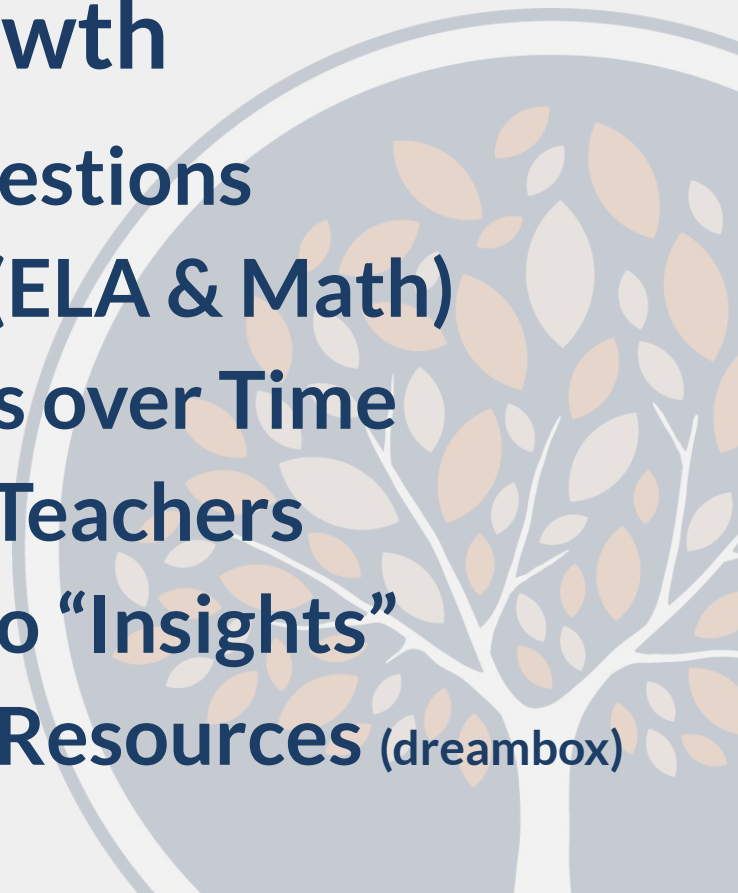
NWEA Map Growth Process

- ▣ Normed by over 10 million students
- ▣ Browser Lock - Electronic Proctoring
