Grade Scale Changes Announced in May 2017

Beginning in the 2020-2021 School Year:

- 1. Students would only receive numerical grades
- 2. Students would receive a GPA on a 100 point scale
- 3. AP courses will be weighted with 5 points (only in calculating the cumulative GPA)
- 4. Cum Laude cut score will be a GPA of 93
- 5. Valedictory honors will be a GPA of 98 or above

Current Practice:

Final grades reported on two scales: 100 and 4.0

GPA reported on 4.0 scale

APs receive a .4 weight

Valedictorians are based on a perfect 4.0 transcript

Cum Laude is based on a 3.8 GPA

Changes Proposed in May 2017

Final grades on a 100 point scale only

GPA reported on 100 point scale

APs receive a 5 point weight

Valedictorians are based on a 98% GPA

Cum Laude is based on a 93% GPA

Effects of Grade Scale Conversion

- 1. Cumulative GPAs in the 4.0 scale are not equivalent to GPAs in the 100 point scale.
- 2. Cum Laude and Valedictorian Honors in the 4.0 scale are not equivalent to the same in the 100 point scale.
- 3. Naviance will not support the conversion.
- 4. Infinite Campus does not support the conversion.
