



# **Contingency Budget – Estimates**

# What is a Contingency Budget?

- When voters reject the proposed budget
- BOE is empowered to levy tax sufficient to pay for cost of items: 1) authorized by statute, and 2) “ordinary contingent expenses”
- Must be within the cap:  
Lesser of: 120% of CPI (1.6%) or 4%
- Information must be included in the Budget Notice

2010-11 Budget: \$109,391,348

2011-12 Proposed Budget: \$111,338,488
