

Using District-wide Assessments To Look at Reading Levels

These reading levels were determined from assessments given to each child in a one-on-one setting in grades K-4. The assessments are given 3 times per year except in kindergarten (given in June). They are used not only to match students to texts, but also to gain an understanding of each student's ability to read accurately and with in-depth comprehension.






