Innovation Opportunities Process

- Studied 25 ideas
- Critiqued proposals across a dozen categories: size, cost, student impact, teacher impact, teaching and learning, priority, light, technology, safety, access, outdoor connection, storage, air, etc...
- Selected most compelling for sharing with faculty
- Conducted table-group discussions
- Aggregated information on student and teacher benefits and concerns, questions, etc....

Faculty Response

- Raised questions about design and process; i.e., private vs. public space (sound and visual), storage, offices etc...
- Suggested new approaches that we had not considered
