## Using District-wide

 Assessments To Look at Reading LevelsThese reading levels were determined from assessments given to each child in a one-on-one setting in grades $\mathrm{K}-4$. The assessments are given 3 times per year except in kindergarten ( given in June). They are used not only to match students to texts, but also to gain an understanding of each student's ability to read accurately and with in-depth comprehension.
