

The Creative Process for fine and design arts


Start with a problem, question or challenge.

Prototype. By high school explore 3 versions. Get Feedback.

Create/revise. Draw, paint, sculpt, design, make... Revise.

Present. Share with peers. Display work. Reflect.














VISION statement created by K-12 teachers
