Arc Westchester

<u>Current Openings:</u> We have very few opportunities at this time due to a lack of staffing. We currently have 8 openings in our site-based day programs located in Southern Westchester. We do not have openings in our community-based or WOW (without walls) day programs at this time.

<u>Waitlists:</u> We will begin screening individuals once we have the resources, staff, and time to do so. We are accepting applications and referral packets for our programs with openings; however, we will not be going forward until we hire more staff and our administrators have the time to review.

Type of Day Habilitation program: site-based and community-based.

Other: Our Day program offers individuals with developmental disabilities a person-centered full or part-time program that facilitates life skills through community and center-based activities. Services may be combined with part-time supported employment, volunteer work, "without walls" options, and/or pre-vocational services. We also have a sensory-based program for adults with complex physical and medical needs that significantly impair their ability to perform activities of daily living.

Without Walls (WOW) Westchester – Using the community as its classroom, small groups (up to 4) participants with I/DD engage in planned activities in the community all day such as volunteer work, attending classes at various colleges and some engage in part-time supported employment and/or internships in the Rockland community.

Westchester "After the Day" Respite Services – "After the Day" Respite services provides a strong focus on learning community life, wellness activities, and developing independence in the community. It is offered 3 afternoons per week and transportation home is provided.
