Welcome to 8th grade! In order to help you with a smooth transition back to school in September, we are sending you a list of school supplies required by the 8th grade team. **You are encouraged to reuse any of the following items that you have at home or from previous years.**

General Supplies:

- Pens – blue or black ink
- #2 pencils
- Highlighters
- Colored pencils
- Expo (thick dry erase) markers - 2 packs/boxes
- Loose-leaf paper (enough for each academic and encore class)
- Ruler
- Earbuds (that don't need to be charged)
- Scientific calculator for Math State Test and Science (*see back*)
- Small pencil sharpener
- Index Cards – 4" x 6"
- Scotch Tape
- Post-it (sticky) notes 3" x 3" (3 booklets)
- Folder for homework. Some students prefer an accordion folder for this purpose.
- Wired Headphones (noise-canceling if possible)
- 1 tissue box

Science:

Math:

- 1x 3-ring binder (rings at least 1" diameter) with a set of 5 dividers (RED)

For English:

For Social Studies:

- 1x 3-ring, 1-inch binder (can be shared with other subjects) (BLUE)

For Living Environment:

World Language:

Information about calculators: We recommend that students have their own calculator; however, if a student does not purchase his/her own calculator, he/she will have the opportunity to borrow one from the school for the school year.

Scientific calculator: can be used for both the Math State Test and science class daily. You may use a scientific calculator that you already own from 6th or 7th grade.

If you are purchasing a new calculator, we recommend the following calculator:

Texas Instruments Scientific Calculator model # TI-30X IIS
(or any scientific calculator with 2-line display)

Graphing calculator: needed for both Algebra 8 and Enriched Algebra and later High School courses. If you purchase a graphing calculator, we recommend:

Texas Instruments TI-84 Plus CE Graphing Calculator
(which is in color and has a rechargeable battery)

These calculators are available in stores as well as online.

Be sure to label your calculators with your name in permanent ink.

Students should also make sure that their home **computer and printer** are ready to go.
